The Board of County Commissioners met in special session on Monday, July 26, 2021 at 1:00 pm.
Chairman Pedersen opened the meeting and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.
Chairman Pedersen took roll call and present were Commissioners Wakefield, Tranby, Urness, Edland, and Pedersen. Also present was Road Superintendent/911 Coordinator Oien, Treasurer Eslinger, Clerk of Court/Recorder Vincent, Sheriff Michaelis, Extension Agent Stachler, State's Attorney Tenneson-present by phone.

Chairman Pedersen opened the floor for any changes to the agenda. Motion by Tranby to accept the agenda as presented, second by Urness and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Pedersen opened the floor to continue discussion the 2022 Budget. There was continued discussion on the salary increases for the employees. Motion by Edland to approve an additional 1.5\% increase/employee on top of the $1.3 \%$ COLA, second by Tranby and called for discussion. There was continued discussion on the subject. Chairman Pedersen called three times for discussion with roll call vote: Wakefieldnay, Tranby-aye, Urness-aye, Edland-aye, Pedersen-nay, and carried. The commission continued to go through the budget as it was presented. Motion by Wakefield to move $\$ 122,725.31$ from the COVID-19 Public Safety Account, move $\$ 54,004.93$ from Emergency, and decrease the General Reserve to $\$ 231,957.35$ to make the County Levy the same as last year, second by Urness and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:21 and the Commission will meeting again in regular meeting on Thursday, August $5^{\text {th }}$ at 2:30.
